

Well, it's day 3 of sporadic water and boil what you get. There is no communication from our Township except a letter 3 weeks ago. It will be another 2 days of boil your water, or so we have heard. You don't even want to know what the water looks like after boiling it.

So, is this article what our boys call a "rant and rave"? No, all moments are teachable moments! When you live by faith (Hebrews) you know life is made up of surprises. Life has moments of awe and wonder – more of them than the hair on fire moments, even in the times we live in.

So, what does this all mean? There is another water supply we take for granted and go on our way, blithely paying little or no attention – baptism. Luther intended baptism to be a living sacrament, not a whiff of nostalgia. Look at the fields of grain, shining like a yellow brick road to remind us that in baptism God is there for us on the journey with more than one surprise.

Baptism is a place, a holy water spring in the midst of every moment to come; take seriously who God is and whose you are. God's water, God's word, still speaks. Enjoy it in awe and play...

Giving thanks to our Lord is an important part of our faith.




The community service committee will be collecting money from 11/3 until 11/25 to help feed a low income senior citizen. The Senior Grocerv Box Program via the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan provides supplemental food boxes to senior citizens each month through annual sponsorship. For \$200 a senior citizen on a fixed income will receive a 45-50 pound box of food each month, including seasonal fresh produce. There will be special envelopes in the Narthex and on the offering pedestals for anyone wanting to donate. Any extra money collected will be split between Carriage Town and the North End Soup Kitchen. As a result of this special collection, there will be no request for "loose change" in November.
