

At the last church

council meeting, our council:

- (4) Scheduled the Annual Congregational Meeting on Sunday, January 19, 2020.
- (5) Approved new church property & liability, and workers' compensation, insurance policies for an annual premium of \$2,587.
- (6) Approved donating the October "Loose Change" collection to Lutheran World Relief.

In October: Laundry Detergent, Fabric Softener, Dryer Sheets, and Canned Fruit




Desert Angels - More to be Done
